Please respect the camp facilities and property.

Guest Lodging:

Check-in is 3pm, check-out is 10:00am, unless prior arrangements have been made.

The registration fee for your CampCation stay does NOT cover housekeeping services for your lodging area. You are responsible for the following:

- * Sweep & shake rugs.
- * Please do not put wet towels or bathing suits over the ends of the wood bunk beds or leave clothing and toiletries in the restrooms.
- * Dump trash in an outside container or put the trash can from your room in the hallway and housekeeping will dump it for you on their morning cleaning rounds.
- * Open food items are prohibited.
- * Please use caution in using extension cords & turn off curling irons and fans when not in use. All extension cords must be a power strip.
- * Please turn lights off if you are the last one out.
- * When you are ready to leave your room/dorm, please do the following:
 - Put all rugs over the end of the beds.
 - Sweep the room/dorm out completely; be sure you check for those dust bunnies under the bed!
 - Put all trash in the trash cans.
 - Leave the room as clean as you found it when you moved in.

Guest Courtesy and Safety:

- * Please follow the camp COVID-19 guidelines—separate document.
- * The use or solicitation of tobacco, ecigs/vaping, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or fire arms or any other weapons are prohibited on camp property. All visitors are requested to refrain from their use.
- * No Dancing.
- * Camp curfew is 11:00pm. No loud music after this time is permitted.
- * Swimming is permitted during regularly scheduled swimming periods when lifeguards are on duty. (Swimming is not permitted after sunset.) Fishing is restricted to camp designated piers. Shoes and a covering must be worn while going to and from the beach. The lifeguards are to be respected and obeyed by both youth and adults. Unacceptable swimsuit attire are as follows: Men & boys - no racer style trunks. Women & girls - no two-piece bathing suits (tankini's are OK), no plunging neckline swimsuits.
- * In matter of dress, Christian judgement must prevail at all times!
 - a. No halter tops, tube tops, spaghetti straps, strapless attire, bare midriff, mini-skirts or spandex shorts at any time. Tank top straps must have straps greater than 2" in width.
 - b. Clothing must completely cover all undergarments. Inappropriate advertisements are not permitted and written expressions across the backside of shorts or pants is not permitted.
 - c. No one is to go barefoot on the camp grounds at any time!!! .
- * Please throw trash in receptacles provided. Help us keep the grounds & buildings litter free. Throw away your pop cans in the proper containers located on the grounds.
- * The dining room area will be closed following supper until 7:45 breakfast daily.
- * Turn off lights! Last one to leave an area please turn off the lights.
- * Toilet paper is the only item that should be flushed in all toilets. Please do not put anything else down the toilets.
- * If you have a maintenance problem or request, stop by the office and fill out a maintenance report and it will be taken care of as soon as possible.
- * No pets are allowed in the buildings or on the grounds. If you brought a pet, see the executive director for local kennels available in the area.
- * Any property damage will be billed to the adult guest(s) on the registration.
- * Lake James Christian Camp will not be responsible for any theft or damage to personal belongings.
